

Sustainable development is development that meets the social, economic, and environmental needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs.

~ Brundtland Commission, "Our Common Future"

Definitions of Sustainability

To achieve sustainability, a system must be ecologically sound, economically viable, socially just and humane (embodying our highest values— how we treat animals, people and the Earth)

Precautionary Principle

"Where there are reasonable grounds for concern for the possibility of adverse effects, priority will be given to human health and the environment, without having to wait until the reality and seriousness of those adverse effects become fully apparent".


Term first used in <u>The World Charter for Nature</u>, adopted by the UN General Assembly, 1982.

- Thomas Berry, Dream of the Earth, The Great Work: "we are in the terminal phase of the Cenozoic Era; the four great establishments of society (business, government, education, religion) promote a radical discontinuity between the human and natural world; and we must establish an integral relationship with the Earth.
- That our current culture cannot provide the path to an integral relationship is much more difficult to grasp and to accept.
